We are requesting that the resident who owns and/or can borrow a house trailer and park it in their driveway so they are living within their community and able to see the progress being made on the repairs of the many damaged homes.

This would solve one of our problems of having families that have separated connected again to their neighbors, friends and their local business district, (banks, doctors, dentists etc)

I understand that the idea of parking the house trailers in the driveway was a unique decision that the township supported previously during Covid for workers who had to isolate from family.

This is similar in the fact that these people have been also through a traumatic experience and being in their own neighborhood will assist them in dealing with this experience.

There are very few options open to house families when there are no rentals available and this is one option that would assist the different organizations working diligently trying to find rental housing for the many displaced families.
