I have spoke to all my neighbours on the Concession Road 6 between Highway 47 and all Goodwood Road and they have voiced the following concerns.


- 1. The number and frequency of large heavy trucks using this stretch of road is increasing and, in many cases, they are exceeding the 60kmh speed limit,
- 2. The residents are concerned about their safety when entering or leaving their driveways, some of which are 'hidden',
- Some of the residents have small children and are concerned for their safety,
- 4. The noise factor is increasing as these vehicles are noisy, use engine braking, and emit noise and fumes when accelerating.

The residents are looking to the Township for a solution to these problems and suggest that the trucks use a more viable road for these vehicles such as Highway 47 or Goodwood Road. The residents suggest that the Township could talk with local businesses with a view to having their delivery vehicles using Highway 47. Additional monitoring of speeds on this road may also help in making life safer for the residents.

Safety, noise, children, and local pollution are major concerns that the residents need addressed, and the residents of the road between Highway 47 and Goodwood Road are now voicing these concerns to the Township.
